Lunchroom Expectations

Here at da Vinci, we strive to create an environment that exemplifies our school wide expectations - We Are Learners, We Are Leaders. This extends to all aspects of the school day, including the lunch room. To that end, we ask that our students practice being Respectful and Safe in the lunchroom by doing the following:

- Keeping hands friendly don't touch other people or food that isn't theirs
- No throwing food
- Keeping lanyards around their necks and using them appropriately
- Using toys or fidgets as they are meant to be used and not throwing them
- No crawling under tables
- No shouting or raising voices unnecessarily
- Students may sit four to a bench

Lunchroom behavior is monitored, addressed, and corrected by our monitors. For the safety of the students, assigned seating may be arranged as a group if behaviors can't be addressed individually.

Students who continue to follow the directions will be acknowledged with leader loot or coupons to sit at our new Reward Table!

Early Release

Keep in mind that April 19th, 2024 will be an early release! School will begin at 7:30 for middle school students and 7:45 for elementary school students and will end at 12:35 for all students. Buses will run 2 hours early as well so students can get to their hub locations like a normal dismissal day (just 2 hours earlier than usual). Elementary students will follow an afternoon schedule.

Solar Eclipse

There will be a Solar Eclipse on Monday, April 8th, 2024. As such, we will be holding recess indoors and keeping blinds shut on all windows that day. We will not be viewing the solar eclipse to avoid the potential effects it may have on eyes when not using the appropriate eye protection. If you would like your student to view the solar eclipse, you or an authorized person may pick up your student from school.

Popcorn Day

There has been a slight change in popcorn dates reflected on the calendar in the newsletter. To avoid distractions and any excessive noise or visitor traffic during Forward Testing, we have opted to move the scheduled popcorn days for the month of April.
